



Policies of The Meetinghouse at Priest Point for OFM Members, Attenders, and Others Using the Meetinghouse

The Olympia Friends Meeting's Rental Committee recognizes the need to balance supporting local organizations with the need for the Meetinghouse to generate revenue to help pay our building costs.

Policies:

Our “regular rate” applies to the public, to for-profit businesses and groups, and to government entities.

Our “non-profit rate” applies to non-profit organizations [with or without 501(c)(3) status]

We offer a 10% discount to frequent renters. A “frequent renter” rents from us more than five times in a calendar year. The discount begins with the 6th event and is ongoing from that point forward — i.e. it is not necessary to start over each year.

1. OFM events created by the Meeting, open to everyone or to specific groups of the Meeting (committee meetings and events, children and families, potlucks, etc.); or something sponsored by the Meeting or a committee or another Quaker group and promoted to the Meeting or the public to let people know they can attend: no charge.
2. Other official Quaker organization events such as NPYM: no charge.
3. OFM Members & active Attenders are offered a 50% discount from the rate that ordinarily applies. You cannot combine that discount with the frequent renter discount.
4. An OFM Member or an active OFM Attender involved in a non-Quaker non-profit organization may get one Friday or Sunday evening or one Saturday daytime event at no charge, or up to three weekday events at no charge, per year. The organizing Member or Attender must be present during — and is responsible for — the event. This is considered a donation in-kind by the Meeting.
